- · Dress Code and Behaviour -
- Students should avoid the use of abusive language, obscene display and revealing costumes during the competitions. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Judging and Competition rules –
- The judge's decision will be final and binding.
- · Participants must review the event rules and strictly adhere to them.
- Time Management and Punctuality –
- · All the events will commence at the scheduled time, punctuality is expected and appreciated.

Registration Fee:- Rs 299/- only.

Team Size: Solo

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Performance must be a folk, Indian classical, semi-classical, Bollywood pop song. English songs are also allowed.
- This competition consists of two rounds.
- · Each participant will have a minimum of 120 seconds and a maximum of 300 seconds for the performance.
- · Negative marking will be there if the performance exceeds the allotted period of time.
- The songs may not contain any obscene lyrics.
- · Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- . If a participant wishes, a participant may make use of a musical instrument to enhance the performance.
- . The performer may make use of their own props, makeup, and clothing to enhance the performance.
- · Pre-recorded soundtracks or live music can be used, but must be provided by the participants.
- Use of cell phones during the performance are prohibited.
- Use of profane and offensive language during the act is prohibited which may lead to disqualification.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- Miming or ventriloquism is STRICTLY not allowed.
- It is compulsory that all the participants adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- The act should be in Hindi or English or both. However short sub-passages in other regional languages are allowed (max: 30-45 seconds).
- · Performance must consist of a single act with no blackouts.
- · Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- Obscenity (at the discretion of the judges) in any of the stages, of any kind, is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Breach of time limits, inappropriate content, or violating any of the competition rules can result in immediate disqualification.
- The use of light-weighted props is allowed.
- Any kind of fluid, flame, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects, or any material that has the possibility
 of tampering/damaging the stage is STRICTLY not allowed.
- · Participants must provide their own props, costumes, and set pieces.

- Pre-recorded music is allowed and should be brought in a pen drive in mp3 format only and should also be submitted in Google Drive format in the "Submit Entry" field by keeping the access **Open To All**.
- . It is compulsory that all the teams adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- · Participated teams will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- · Any kind of fluid, flame, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects, or any material that has the
- The possibility of tampering/damaging the stage is STRICTLY not allowed.
