- Event Duration 2 Days
- Event Date 1st 2nd March 2025
- Time 09:00 A.M. Onwards
- Registration and entry Requirements –
- Students taking part in the events should register through the given link. On-the-spot entry is prohibited.
- Students will not be allowed without college ID cards. They also have to bring their Aadhar card, Verification from their college (i.e., Letter head, fee receipt, Last semester or year result)
- Theme-
- It is compulsory that all the teams and participants adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- Dress Code and Behaviour –
- Students should avoid the use of abusive language, obscene display and revealing costumes during the competitions. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Judging and Competition rules –
- The judge's decision will be final and binding.
- Participants must review the event rules and strictly adhere to them.
- Time Management and Punctuality -
- All the events will commence at the scheduled time, punctuality is expected and appreciated.
- Change in Rules and Regulations –
- Rules are subject to changes at the discretion of the Management or Organizers.
- Discipline and decorum –
- Discipline and proper decorum should be maintained all the times.

SUR TARANG" (SOLO- SINGING COMPETITION) -

Description-This is a solo singing competition where singers will perform music (Light Vocal, Western and Folk format) performance that can be sung with or without accompaniment by musical instruments.

Team Size: Solo

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Performance must be a folk, Indian classical, semi-classical, Bollywood pop song. English songs are also allowed.
- This competition consists of two rounds.
- Each participant will have a minimum of 120 seconds and a maximum of 300 seconds for the performance.
- Negative marking will be there if the performance exceeds the allotted period of time.
- The songs may not contain any obscene lyrics.
- Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- If a participant wishes, a participant may make use of a musical instrument to enhance the performance.
- The performer may make use of their own props, makeup, and clothing to enhance the performance.
- Pre-recorded soundtracks or live music can be used, but must be provided by the participants.
- Use of cell phones during the performance are prohibited.
- Use of profane and offensive language during the act is prohibited which may lead to disqualification.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- Lyrics and Pitch 30 marks
- Presentation and Song Selection and use of instrument (if any) 25 marks
- Originality and Creativity 20 marks
- Interpretation and expression 15 marks

- This competition consists of two rounds.
- Negative marking will be there if the performance exceeds the allotted period of time.
- The songs may not contain any obscene lyrics.
- Participated teams will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- If a team wishes, a participant may make use of a musical instrument to enhance the performance.
- The performers may make use of their own props and clothing to enhance the performance.
- Pre-recorded soundtracks or live music can be used, but must be provided by the teams.
- Use of cell phones during the performance are prohibited.

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Performance must be a folk, Indian classical, semi-classical, Bollywood pop song. English songs also allowed.
- It is compulsory that all the teams adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- Each team will have a minimum of 240 seconds and a maximum of 480 seconds for the performance.
- Negative marking will be there if the performance exceeds the allotted period of time.
- The songs may not contain any obscene lyrics.
- Participated teams will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- An additional time will not be allotted to each team for any setup. Negative marking will be present if it takes longer than expected.
- If a team wishes, a team may make use of a musical instrument to enhance the performance.
- The performer may make use of own props and clothing to enhance the performance.
- Pre-recorded soundtracks or live music can be used, but must be provided by the team.
- Use of cell phones during the performance are prohibited.
- Use of profane and offensive language during the act is prohibited which may lead to disqualification.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- Lyrics and Pitch 30 marks
- Presentation and Song Selection and use of intruments (if any) 25 marks
- Originality and Creativity 20 marks

- Time Limit: 10 minutes (including setup and clearance time i.e. empty stage to empty stage).
- All Contestants are expected to carry their own music (Vinyl, CDs and/or pen drives), Headphones, Slip Mats & Needles.
- Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- DJ Systems are provided by the organizers and it should be arranged by the participants.
- DVS Systems (Trackton, Serrato, etc.) or any Ableton live setup would not be allowed in this competition.
- There would be no separate Vinyl or CD Round.
- Any abusive track will not be entertained.
- Please refrain from copying and stealing the tracks as it would immediately lead to disqualification.
- Violation of any of the rules will lead to disqualification.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

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% "NRITYA NATH" (GROUP- DANCE COMPETITION) –

Description-This is a duo dance competition where dancers will perform dance (folk, Semi-folk and Western format) performance that can be performed with or without accompaniment by props. Team Size: 5-10 +1 (CA for sound if needed)

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Performance must be in a category of folk, Indian classical, Semi-classical, Western form.
- Each team will have a minimum of 240 seconds and a maximum of 300 seconds for the performance.
- It is compulsory that all the teams adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- Negative marking will be there if the performance exceeds the allotted period of time.
- Participated teams will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- Usage of props is allowed. These have to be brought by the teams themselves but the organizers hold the discretion of allowing it on stage.
- The losses/damage to the props is not the responsibility of organizers and the teams will be heavily penalized if damage to the stage occurs because of these.
- Teams have to submit their tracks (in mp3 format only) and prod-list in Google Drive format in the "Submit Entry" field by keeping the access **Open To All.**
- The soundtrack should also be brought in a pen drive (in mp3 format only) during Technoaagaz.
- Any kind of fluid, flame, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects, or any material that has the
 possibility of tampering/damaging the stage is STRICTLY not allowed.
- Vulgarity and obscenity at any point are strictly not allowed. It can lead to immediate disqualification. Songs should be chosen accordingly.

- Performers have to clear the stage in the given time after their performance otherwise they will be penalized heavily by the organizers.
- Violation of any of the above rules will lead to heavy penalties.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

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SAMAJ KI AWAAZ" (NUKKAD NATTAK COMPETITION) -

Description- A Nukkad Natak (street play) is a vibrant and impactful form of theater performed in an open space. This type of drama is characterized by its minimal use of props, exaggerated expressions, and loud vocal delivery, ensuring that it communicates effectively to people at a distance.

Team Size: 5-15 members only

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Time Limit: 8 -10 minutes (including setup and clearance time i.e. empty stage to empty stage).
- Teams have to submit a drive link that contains the synopsis of their play (not more than 100 words) and a prod list (list of production material and musical instruments brought by the teams).
- It is compulsory that all the teams adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- Any kind of fluid, flame, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects, or any material that has the possibility of tampering/damaging the stage is STRICTLY not allowed.
- Participated teams will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- The essence of the play should be brought out in Hindi or English or both. However, short snippets in other regional languages are allowed (max. 30 seconds).
- Drama can be based on selected theme but since eliminations are being held at public venues, inappropriate content, blasphemy, or content defaming any political party or religious group is STRICTLY prohibited.
- Obscenity (at the discretion of judges) is not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- No electrical appliances (for example, amplifiers) shall be allowed during the performance, whether inside or outside the circle of performance. No plug points will be provided for this purpose.
- You cannot play any recorded music using mobile phones or tapes.
- No extra time for rehearsals will be provided.
- Violation of any of the rules will lead to disqualification from subsequent rounds.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Judgement Criteria:
- Voice modulation & Variety of characters 30 marks
- Delivery of dialogues 25 marks
- Storyline & Flow of expression 20 marks
- Acting skills, Synchronisation & Coordination 15 marks
- Confidence, stage presence and time factor-10 marks

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GLAMOUR GALA" (FASHION SHOW) -

Description- It is a fashion walk competition which showcases stylish outfits, creativity, and design skills. It includes runway walks, themed presentations, and performances, celebrating fashion, trends, and individual expression.

Team Size: 5-15+1 (CA if needed)

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Participants will have to make an outfit depending on the theme.
- The total time limit of a team is 05-10 minutes (including setup and performance).
- Maximum two teams are allowed to participate from a particular college.
- It is compulsory that all the teams adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- The vulgarity of any kind would lead to disqualification of the team from the event. Hence, if the team feels that any stunt or costume design can be considered vulgar, it is strongly advised to consult the organizers before displaying it for the finals. The decision of the organizers will be final in case of any disputes arising due to this.
- Pre-recorded music is allowed and should be brought in a pen drive in mp3 format only and should also be submitted in Google Drive format in the "Submit Entry" field by keeping the access **Open To All**.
- Participated teams will be required to assemble 60 minutes prior to the event.
- No branding on clothes will be allowed.
- Use of props is permitted.
- Any kind of fluid, flame, powders, glitters, heavy or sharp objects, or any material that has the possibility of tampering/damaging the stage is STRICTLY not allowed.
- Required music tracks shall be arranged by the team itself.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding on all.
- No animals or birds should be harmed in the making of the designs. Doing so will lead to immediate disqualification.

Team Size: Solo

Rules:

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- Speeches must adhere to a time limit, usually 5-8 minutes.
- Participants should strictly follow the allotted time. Exceeding or under-delivering time limits may result in point deductions.
- The speech must be original and not plagiarized.
- It is compulsory that all the participants adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- Topics: The topics will be given on the spot but it will be around the theme.
- Participants will get 10 minutes for research and prepare for their speech preparation.
- No vulgar language will be tolerated while speaking.
- Speeches must be delivered in the specified language (e.g., English, Hindi, or any other designated language).
- Participants are expected to maintain decorum and professionalism throughout the event.
- Any participant who uses offensive language, disruptive behaviour, or fails to follow the rules may be disqualified.
- Violation of any of the rules will lead to disqualification.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- Registration must be completed within the designated time frame to be eligible for participation.
- No preview of the code or output is allowed until the challenge ends.
- The challenge involves solving programming problems by writing code "blindly" (without seeing syntax highlights, autocompletion, or error messages).
- Participants can use only [mention tools, e.g., Notepad or a specific IDE in restricted mode].
- Use of electronic devices, external notes, or internet access is strictly prohibited.
- Participants will be required to assemble 30 minutes prior to the event.
- Kindly bring your own laptops, charges, and any essentials you need for the challenge.
- Any form of cheating or assistance from others will result in immediate disqualification.
- Each participant must write the code for a given problem.
- Participants whose code gets executed will be given higher preference.
- The second preference will be given to code with the least number of errors.
- In case of tie in number of errors, TIME of SUBMISSION will be considered.

- Participants should carry their own utensils (including colours, pencil, etc.). No utensils will be
 provided by organizers.
- It is compulsory that all the participants adhere to the Technoaagaz theme that is "Diversity and Exclusivity".
- No references are allowed to be carried by the participants. Any explicit content shall lead to straight disqualification.
- Only one sheet would be given. So, the participants should take special care to not spoil the sheet. An A4-sized paper would be given which could be used for rough work
